The site lists our location and phone number. Most other information is from 2004 and 2005. The site gives Joe Conroy's name and phone number to call for further information.

Our second attempt was an update of the previous site by Dick Berger, who does web sites for several other tennis organizations and groups. Although Dick was given a family membership for his services we usually only saw him when he was helping us. He plays most of his tennis at Genesys where he is also a member. He paid web fees out of his own pocket so the club incurred no expenses.

Our third web site is our current and most impressive looking site. It was developed by Chris Foster from Momentum Enterprises. The board will make a decision after this year to either keep paying for this site or (if he is still willing) return to our free site maintained by Dick Berger.


From the President


